Literacy/Communication:

Our English will 'run' through our theme and the children will be developing their grammar, punctuation and spelling through themed writing and our focus text 'The Boy at the Back of the Class.' We will be writing our own narratives and comic strips.

Numeracy:

In Maths, we will be focusing on being able to tell the time. Children will be taught how to read both an analogue and digit clock.

Science: As Scientists we will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Computing:

We will be using the IPADS to research different charities.

Geography: As Geographers, we will be using a map, to plot the journey Ahmet would take from Syria to Great Britain. We will also be learning about what life is like in Syria? Exploring the culture, food, buildings, religion.
