Literacy/Phonics:

In English we will be working on our writing skills, focusing on basic punctuation and grammar and using our Phonics skills to sound out words. We will be reading books about toys which link to our History topic and using those to help us write for different purposes. In Phonics we will continue to practise the sounds we already know, learning some new phonemes and beginning to recognise some new tricky and high-frequency words.

Numeracy:

This term we will be exploring numbers to 10, to ensure we know them inside out. We will be sorting groups of real life objects and learning a variety of different ways to make 10. Using real objects, pictures and numbers we will be learning to become flexible and creative problem-solvers.

Science:

We will be looking at the weather, spending time outside observing it. We will be spotting the changes of the Seasons and later in the term we will make our own rain gauges to measure how much rain falls at Stanstead.

Music:

As part of our main topic theme, we will be listening to the music of The Beatles. We will think about how it makes us feel as well as learning one of their songs to perform for our peers.

History:

This term we will be learning all about the 1960s. We will be looking at food and clothing from the 60s, as well as finding out what it was like to go to school during that time. When thinking about our lead question, we will look at modern toys to see how they compare to those from the 1960s.

Computing:

We will be talking about the technology we use at home and how it compares to the technology our grandparents had in when they were children in the 1960s.

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be learning about a wide range of feelings. We will talk about how people's feelings can be hurt and what it means to be kind.

RE: We will be thinking about what it means to belong.

We will talk about the different groups we belong to, including our families and the things we do together. We will also learn about what Christian families do together.

D&T: We will be designing and making our own moving cars, based on some of the most popular cars of the 1960s. We will also evaluate them to see how we can improve them.

PE: This term we will be focusing on basic moves and team games. This includes practising our throwing and catching skills, as well as how to work together in a team.
