Animal Antics

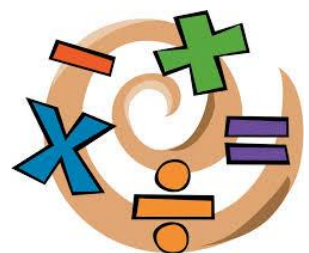

The class will be provided with many opportunities to ask questions, research and show what they have learnt both in writing and practically. Our English will 'run' through our theme and the children will be developing their grammar, punctuation and spelling through a variety of writing based on Animals.



We will be comparing and classifying different types of animals and exploring their habitats. We will also be looking at how animals adapt to suit their environment.

In Maths, we will be focusing on our knowledge of place value, using accurate written methods for the four operations and working on fractions. We will be developing our reasoning skills in writing as well as orally.

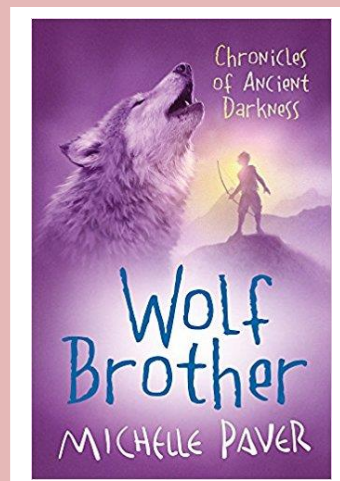
