Year group: 6

Literacy/Communication:

Our English will 'run' through our theme and the children will be developing their grammar, punctuation and spelling- including relative clauses, semi-colons and prepositional phrases -through themed writing on Animals. Their writing will include: non-chronological reports, narrative texts, with a particular focus on description, and a discussion text. The children will be developing their reading skills through the use of reading journals. They will have the opportunity to do a range of activities to support and show their comprehension of texts.

Numeracy:

In Maths, we will be focusing on securing our knowledge of place value, using accurate written methods for the four operations and working on decimals, percentages and their equivalence to fractions. These will be explored in a variety of ways and by exploring a variety of problems to enhance our skills of application. We develop our reasoning skills in writing as well as orally.

Science: We will be comparing and classifying different types of animals and exploring their habitats. We will also be looking closely at how animals adapt to their environments.

Computing: We will be using the i-pad to create a nature documentary, which will include pictures, text and audio. We will also be using book-creator to create information in different biomes.
