PE for Caterpillars and Butterflies will be on Tuesday. The children do NOT need a PE kit for this.

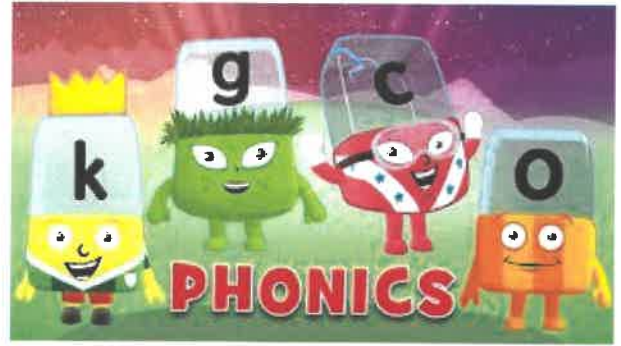
PE for Rainbows will be on Monday. The children will need a named PE kit in a named PE bag. Please make sure that the children are not wearing jewellery.
