Describe and draw what happens when you write a word on a piece of paper and then look at it in a mirror.	Build a model plane used in WW2. First research which planes were used by the Allies, then design and make it.	Create a World War 2 quiz including at least 5 questions. Challenge your teacher and family and friends to answer them.	Can you complete some multiplication and division sums at home? Be sure to include your 3, 4, and 8 times table. Challenge: Can you create your own problem question for Miss Uppal to answer.
Light from the sun can be dangerous for both your eyes and skin. Write a short list including ways to protect yourself.	Find out about one of the countries involved in World War 2. Present some facts about the country at the time. You could include their flag, a picture of their leader and a map of the country etc.	Create a presentation about what you would pack if you were evacuated to another place today, giving your reason for each item.	Can you tell Miss Uppal the currency which was used in WW2?
Draw a bar chart or a pictogram to show which room in your house has most light sources.	Make your own artefact from World War 2. This could be a rationing book, an evacuation case, a gas mask, soldier's helmet, a medal or idea of your own.	Make a news report about the start of WW2. Ask your family or friends to help and film it so you can show your class. 	Multiplication- Practice using the grid method at home. Bring in your own questions to show Miss Uppal.
