Literacy/Communication:

Our English will 'run' through our theme and the children will be developing their grammar, punctuation and spelling through themed writing and our focus text 'Katie in London'. We will be writing a diary entry from the view point of Katie.

Numeracy:

In Maths, we will be focusing on our knowledge of place value, ensuring children have a good understanding of the value of digits in 3 digit numbers; we will be applying this knowledge to problems. We will also be developing our reasoning skills in writing as well as orally.

Science: As Scientists we will be focusing on plants and identifying and describing the function of different parts of a plant. We will be exploring the requirements of plants for life and growth and investigating the way in which water is transported within plants.

Computing:

We will be creating persuasive adverts on what we can do to save the environment.

MFL: We will be developing our knowledge of French culture and extending French vocabulary.

Geography: As Geographers, we will be finding out about where we live in the world and how to locate different countries, cities, and towns. We will also be exploring our environment and whether zoos are the best places for animals.

Art and design: In art we will be researching about the famous artist Banksy. We will also be using different materials to create pieces of art work; these will include charcoal, paints, oil pastels.
