Challenge: Can you complete at least 3 different pieces of homework this term?

Writing	Can you write a setting description about the Rainforest or Antarctica? Remember to include conjunctions in your sentences (and, but, because). I would like at least 5 sentences in your description.	Create a fact file about your favourite animal. Where does it live, what does it eat, what animal group does it belong to? I wonder if you could include at least 5 WOW facts that the other children might not know!	Can you create a description about a penguin or a tiger? Remember to include lots of interesting adjectives! You could also do a drawing with the description. I would like at least 5 sentences in your description.
Research	We know that penguins like to live in cold places like Antarctica but can you find out about any penguins that like to live in warmer climates? (clue - Galapagos Islands)	There isn't just one type of penguin. There are 100's of different types. Research into the different types of penguins and explain why they are the same and different.	Can you research into the different animals that belong in these different animal families: mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians? Make a poster showing what you have found.
Creative	Can you make your own penguin habitat? Remember a penguin needs a place to swim, food to eat and snow to walk on. Add labels to your habitat to explain what each piece is. (idea - it could be made inside a shoe box).	Can you make an animal costume? Make yourself into an animal and wear it at school. You will have to tell us lots of information about your animal, including the animal group it belongs to.	Can you make a 3D animal? Think about the materials that you could use and try to make an animal that can stand up alone!
