This half term our Theme based learning is based on Inventions and Discoveries. This will be tackled through some of our reading and writing activities as well as other curriculum subjects.



It is still expected that every child in class 6 regularly reads in and out of school and ALWAYS has a reading book at their reading ability available in school.
