



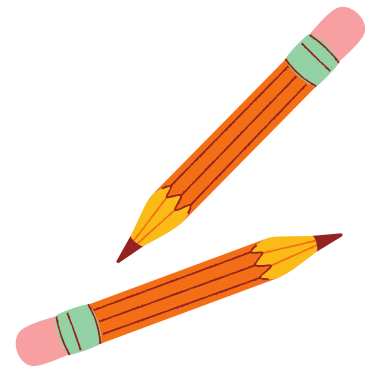

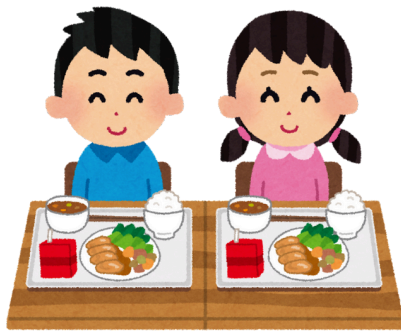
We've had such a brilliant first 3 days at school. The children have settled in so well, playing and exploring the provision beautifully! You should be so proud of your child.
